Adoptable Projects

The Bluff Springs Campground Board of Directors has several projects available for adoption. If you would like to donate your time, talents or funds to any of the following projects please contact Vi Buntz, 2028 Pollard Road, Honoraville, AL 36042. Her phone number is 334-382-9727.

1. Replace windows in the dining hall — Est. cost: \$15,000
 2. Build deck around cafeteria for overflow and socializing before & after meals — Est. cost: \$15,000
 3. Frame in area around children's play area and fill with a 12" bed of sand
 4. Landscaping
 - a. Trim damaged azaleas around the cabins
 - b. Weed flower beds and add flowers
 - c. Pressure wash memory benches
 5. Cabins Maintenance
 - a. Replace molding in cabins
 - b. Install shelves and hooks in bathroom and sink areas
 - c. Install vents over shower area to remove moisture
 - d. Replace ceiling boards as needed
 6. Pressure wash restrooms located outside the dining hall to prepare for painting
 7. Paint
 - a. Back of nurse's cabin outside and inside
 - b. Gate around A/C units behind kitchen
 - c. Bathrooms located outside dining hall
 - d. Dormitory to match cabins
 8. Rebuild bridge on Fitness Trail
 9. Replace or rebuild doors on equipment shed
 10. Replace damaged exterior doors on Activity Building — Est. cost: \$60 per door & \$120 per double door
 11. Build a play area for the special needs children that attend Camp Skamp
 12. Replace ceiling in hot water heater storage area in the kitchen
 13. Replace rotten wood on bridge between Dorm and Cabins
 14. Repair pier including replacement of rotten boards, ladder support
 15. Deep cleaning of all buildings
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
